Submissions may be for one large piece or several smaller pieces that can be displayed within this area (additional work can also be submitted to allow for off-the-shelf sales).

Fire and Earth features the use of clay in its widest array, from the beautifully functional, to sculptural installation. This curated exhibition presents the best submissions received from Scottish Potters Association members. Most of the work will be for sale.

The Scottish Potters Association's new exhibition on the theme of "Fire and Earth" highlights ceramic art in Scotland at a time when many of the higher education colleges are closing their ceramics courses and departments.

The Scottish Potters Association has been in existence for over 30 years. Its original aim "to raise the standards and awareness of the craft whenever possible" remains the main focus of the group. The association regularly meets to share techniques, ideas and experiences with each other and with the audience for Scottish crafts. - **Please complete the entry form below and return it to exhibitions@scottishpotters.org by Monday 10 October 2010 with a short CV and artist statement attached** (may be used to market the exhibition and may be passed onto buyers if requested).
- Please label your work clearly, including your contact details.
